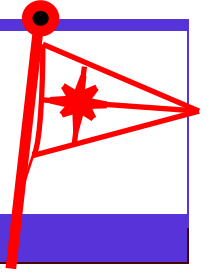


# San Leandro Yacht Club

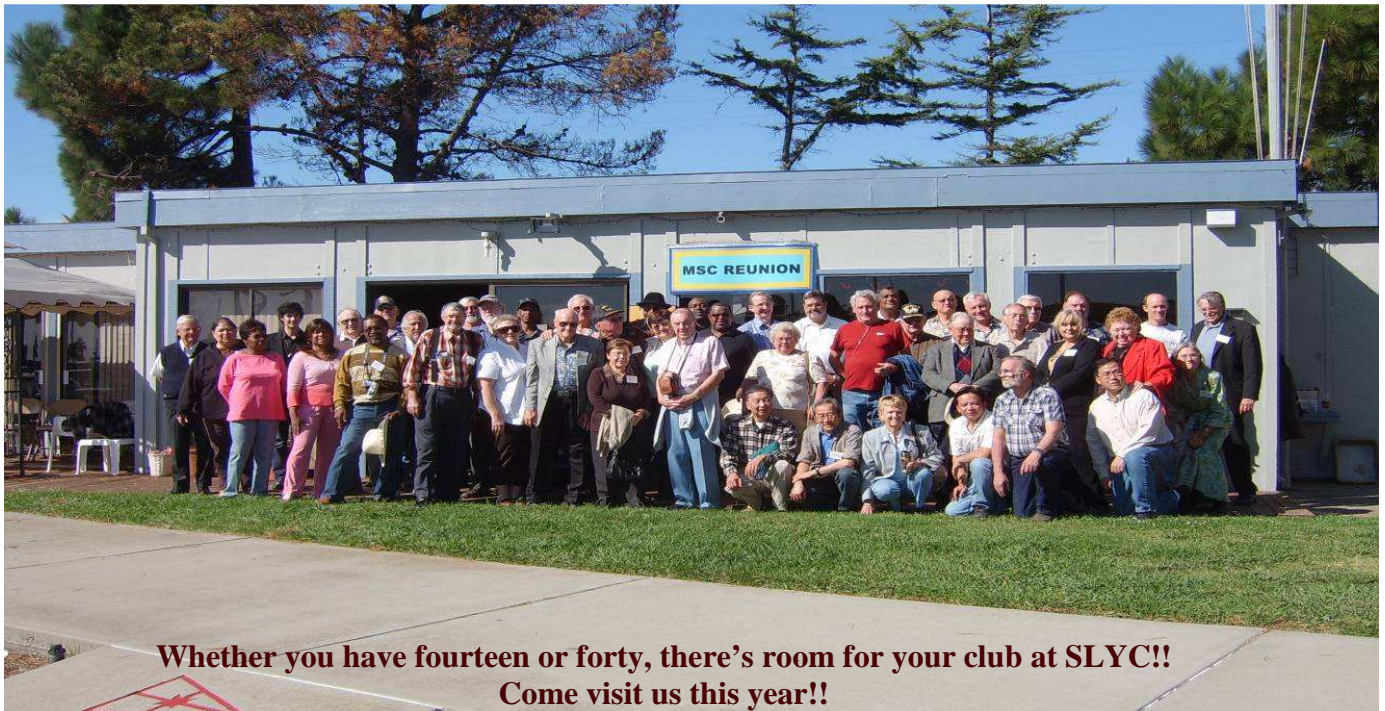


## AHOY, BOATERS IN SEARCH OF A CRUISE DESTINATION!!

We are the San Leandro Yacht Club, tucked up in a corner of the San Leandro Marina, just south of the Oakland Airport, and we are awaiting your club's visit later this year. We are an all-volunteer club, with a core of dedicated members eager to meet your group when you tie up here.

The entrance channel to our marina is about 8 miles south of the Bay Bridge, making us an easy day's travel from nearly all Bay Area marinas. When you arrive, you will find gated concrete docks with either 30 or 50 amp service available, as well as secured heads with showers for berthers and guests.

We have a cozy clubhouse, which has a lovely view of the marina and the beautiful summer sunsets over the Bay. We are located in the middle of the San Leandro Shoreline Park, with walking trails and 27 holes of golf nearby. Some groups get here early enough to have their own 9-hole golf tournament, and award their prizes after dinner in the club. We can accommodate groups up to 50 for dinner.

Our galley facilities are modest, but we have some great (volunteer) chefs, who are willing to be grilling for you!!
